- **A Retreat Center emerges** - In the early 1930s, despite the Great Depression, Bishop Jeanmard set out to establish a new retreat center in the Diocese that could be used for laity and clergy alike. For one hundred years, the Jesuits had resided on the peaceful grounds of Grand Coteau. It was there that Bishop Jeanmard was able to erect a retreat house under the title of Our Lady of the Oaks. The retreat center was built on the grounds of St. Charles College in a distinct Spanish-mission style. The first retreat was held there in October 1938, with Bishop Jeanmard leading the retreat. It continues to serve hundreds of retreatants every year.
