From Msgr. Harrington...

How did Jesus connect with people during His ministry on earth? He healed them, He brought them back from the dead, He encountered them along the way, He walked with them. As we have seen in the past few weeks, He engaged His people by telling stories.

The parables are those stories where Jesus encounters His people through the wonder of storytelling. Although the parables usually have some lesson or moral imperative attached to them, they really are narratives of people's lives. Jesus was reading the human heart. Why people made the decisions they made or why they chose one thing over

Who is your neighbor? Here is a story about your neighbor and what it means to understand the width and breadth of that reality. How important is the kingdom of heaven? Here are stories that show the desperation of many when they lose sheep or coins, and how valuable the kingdom can be for our lives. The kingdom is that valuable. How are you supposed to serve others? To tend to the least and to lift them up is to tend to Jesus Himself. How are you to show mercy? Listen to the story of a father who has lost his sons and embraces their return with a blinding and ferocious

Story after story is not just about what we should do but about what we are capable of doing. A parable illustrates for us the possibility of authentic love. We can do this. We can face the seemingly impossible by entering into the mystery of Jesus' story. In fact, we can only do this with His involvement in our stories. His life amidst the people of Israel is a parable in and of itself. His story changes the world. His story changes each and every one of us. His story fills our with an abundance of life, an embarrassment of riches.

To listen and learn from the 'parable' of Jesus is to open our hearts to the transforming power of God's grace. In this instance, the storyteller becomes the story. Through His words, through His actions, through His very being, He molds and fashions the world into His image and likeness.

To enter into the story of Jesus is to enter into the conversation of God, the Word made flesh. The Word dwells among us. Touching and moving our hearts to become more like His. We become part of the story, a wondrous part of the 'parable' of Jesus of Nazareth, the Christ of God.
