## **CALCUTTA HOUSE (Offertory Collection)**

The Offertory Collection taken on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception will benefit the Calcutta House, a project of Hospice of Acadiana. The Calcutta House is a 12-bed, 8,500 square foot home that will provide quality end-of-life care for those terminal patients whose symptoms can no longer be managed in a home setting; those patients who may not have a home, or not have a home conducive to a dignified death (i.e. unsafe, unsanitary, etc.); or for those patients who may not have anyone to care for them in their final days of life. Staffed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, the Calcutta House will care for approximately 800 terminal patients on an annual basis.
