

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We first see the establishment of this important feast day in the latter part of the thirteenth century. Starting in Liege, France, it spread to other dioceses and eventually was established as a feast day for the whole church by Pope Urban IV. It was seen as necessary then to set a special day aside to recognize this most important gift of Jesus, the gift of His body and blood. It is necessary even today.

Where would we be if we had not been given such a gift? So many of us desperately missed the Eucharist during the pandemic.
