We have heard so many people voicing their frustration with the year 2020 that we wonder more can come our way. It has been a real struggle for so many that we might find it a bit of a strain to be grateful for anything. We just celebrated Thanksgiving and maybe found it difficult to express our thankfulness when so much has gone wrong and everything seemed to be a challenge.

But this weekend with the First Sunday of Advent it is time to start a new year, a new liturgical year. Even though we may still be facing some of the same challenges that have come our way, we do so with a renewed sense of purpose, a new sense of preparation.

The phrase "Come, Lord Jesus" becomes the anthem for all of us. The prayer becomes the vehicle that expresses the longing of our hearts. We want to start the new year with that longing for Jesus to reveal Himself to us as we grasp on to hope and face the new year not with suspicion but with openness and trust in

Advent is that time of preparation, that time to allow God's grace to purge us so that we might be ready to welcome the Lord's coming. 


