The Baptism of the Lord!

This weekend as we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, we are reminded of the words of the Catechism of the Catholic Church as pertains to our own Baptism:

"Through Baptism the Christian is sacramentally assimilated to Jesus, who in his own baptism anticipates his death and resurrection. The Christian must enter into this mystery of humble self-abasement and repentance, go down into the water with Jesus in order to rise with him, be reborn of water and the Spirit so as to become the Father's beloved son in the Son and "walk in newness of life"

By association, we are also reminded of another sacrament, The Sacrament of Confirmation, of which St. Paul writes to the Corinthians:

"Indeed, through Confirmation Christians, consecrated by the anointing in Baptism, share in the fullness of the Spirit with whom Jesus is filled, so that their whole life will spread the 'aroma of Christ' (2 Corinthians 2:15)."

The unique bond of these two sacraments encourages us to link them in as timely a manner as is practical. Therefore, we at St. Landry are taking steps toward lowering the age of Confirmation over the next couple of years. We are offering the Sacrament of Confirmation to 9th, 10th and 11th grade students in our Celebration of the Sacrament in 2021.
