**Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name.** The prayer that Jesus taught His disciples, who in turn passed it down to us, begins with an acknowledgment of the Father's presence. The word for father (Abba) is usually translated as Papa. This opening declaration speaks of the closeness of the Creator to the creation. Just as at the beginning of time, the Creator is in the sanctuary of heaven, the place of peace and perfect love.

**thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.** Jesus now asks the Father to bring the perfection of heaven to the earth. It is interesting to note that the one who is the perfect reflection of this movement of grace is the one who is teaching the prayer. Jesus is the one who brings the Father's will to the earth.


**Give us this day our daily bread.** All nourishment, all sustenance comes from the hand of God. The covenant made between God and Abraham, that same covenant that we share with God, reminds us of our total reliance upon the Father. He is our God, we are His people. Each day we call upon Him to feed us with His grace, His peace, His love. He is the source of our lives, the bread from heaven that dispels all hunger and thirst.

**and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.** Here is where we begin to voice our connection to the covenant. Since it is God who feeds us, then our lives, our decisions, our behavior should reflect that of the Bread from Heaven. We want our brokenness to be forgiven, but we also make the commitment to forgive the brokenness of others. Those two realities are bound to one another; to be forgiven, we must forgive.

**and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.** Trusting that the Father is now imbedded in our lives, we ask Him to walk with us through the darkness of sin and lead us away from the evil that threatens the covenant. We want to remain faithful, and we want Him to help us throughout the journey.

We trust in the presence of God to enter our lives, sustain us, shroud us in mercy and lead us back to Himself. We trust in Him. **For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours now and forever. Amen.**
