From Msgr. Harrington ...

There are times in our day where we all need to stop in the busy-ness of things and recognize our need to praise the God of our lives, the God we are in covenant with. We take so much for granted that we forget to acknowledge the author of all life, the composer who sang us into being. I recommend taking a short phrase or a sentence from Psalm 33, memorize it, and reflect on it throughout each day this week.

Psalm 33

Exult you just in the Lord; praise from the upright is fitting. Give thanks to the Lord on the harp; with the ten stringed lyre chant His praises.

Sing to Him a new song; pluck the strings skillfully, with shouts of gladness. For upright is the word of the Lord, and all his works are trustworthy.

He loves justice and right; of the kindness of the Lord the earth is full.

By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, by the breath of His mouth all their host. He gathers the waters of the sea as in a flask: in cellars he confines the deep.

Let all the earth fear the Lord; let all who dwell in the world revere Him. For He spoke, and it was made; He commanded, and it stood forth.

The Lord brings to naught the plans of nations; he foils the designs of peoples. But the plan of the Lord stands forever; the design of His heart through all generations. Happy the nation whose God is the Lord, the people He has chosen for His own inheritance.

From heaven the Lord looks down; He sees all mankind. From His fixed throne He beholds all who dwell on the earth, He who fashioned the heart of each, He knows all their works.

A king is not saved by a mighty army, nor is a warrior delivered by great strength. Useless is the horse for safety; great though its strength, it cannot provide escape.

But see, the eyes of the Lord are upon those who fear Him, upon those who hope for His kindness, to deliver them from death and preserve them in spite of famine.

Our soul waits for the Lord, who is our help and our shield, for in Him our hearts rejoice; in His holy name we trust. May your kindness, O Lord, be upon us as we place our hope in you.
