We now enter the holiest of weeks. This is the time for remembering. This is the time for us to celebrate the most extraordinary moment in human history. The Son of God emptied Himself, surrendered His life before the hatred and violence of a broken world so that we might be forgiven, so that we might know the love of God that carries us to the Father's presence. How grateful are we for so great a sacrifice on Jesus' part? How grateful are we that the Son of God did this bold and drastic measure so that we might truly live?

Holy week reminds us of Jesus' sacrifice and resurrection. He brings us through the shadow of death to the brightness of the garden of resurrection. He brings us to a new garden of Eden, where all sin is washed away, all pain and sorrow dispersed, and death no longer has dominion. We no longer crawl on our bellies like serpents, writhing in shame and guilt. We stand before God with our faces in the sun, our souls embraced by the Son. We know Easter joy is the Father's gift to us. And for that we are eternally grateful.
