Easter Sunday

Alleluia (praise God) is the ancient word that we proclaim this day and this season. We are so overwhelmed by God's love, by the compassion of Jesus, the resurrection of Jesus, our own resurrection and those of the people we love that we hardly have the words to respond to such generosity. Our hearts are full on this Easter morning.

The women went to the tomb to do final anointings of the body of the savior only to come upon an empty tomb, a transformed darkness into the brightness of resurrection. In some accounts they are the first to encounter the Risen Lord. What was that like?

The Christian song by Bart Mallard, "I Can Only Imagine", presents some of the same moments. What must it have been like for Mary Magdalen, for instance, to encounter Jesus in the garden that day? How do you maintain your presence when you are in the presence of a risen person, especially one you loved and mourned for? How could she control herself and show patience to those who didn't believe her?

What will it be like for us? We can only imagine. The very idea of greeting the Lord face to face, surrendering before His presence in complete joy and peace is truly overwhelming. Yet that is what we celebrate at Easter, our encounter with the Risen Lord.

New life is all around us and within us. Where we began Lent in the desert now we stand fully alive in the garden. Where we began in doubt and fear now our posture is one of confidence in the Lord. In the desert He came to us. In the dark valley He came to us. On the mountain of transfiguration, He came to us. On the Mount of Olives, in our agony and His, He came to us. Now He leads us all to the garden of resurrection. This is our true home, our Eden where we were meant to live.

We can only imagine how wondrous this garden will be. But we are given a glimpse of it now as we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus.

On behalf of the staff and community of St. Landry Catholic Church, I would like to wish all of you a Happy and Blessed Easter. He is Risen. Alleluia!
