Divine Mercy Sunday

In "The Merchant of Venice", a play by William Shakespeare, there is a monologue by Portia in the Venetian Court of Justice where she begs Shylock for mercy. There are a few excerpts I would like to share with you.

The quality of mercy is not strained. It droppeth as the gentle rain from heaven upon the place beneath.

It is twice blest: It blesseth him that gives and him that takes. 'Tis mightiest in the mightiest; it becomes the throned monarch better than his crown.

...Mercy is enthroned in the hearts of kings; it is an attribute of God Himself; and earthly power doth then show likest God's when mercy seasons justice.

...In the course of justice none of us should see salvation. We do pray for mercy, and that same prayer doth teach us all to render the deeds of mercy.

On this Divine Mercy Sunday, we ask our God to reveal His mercy to us, so that we in turn will be merciful to others. This unbridled compassion of God is more than forgiveness for our sins. It is a total embrace of who we are, a claiming by God of His own. His whole personhood enfolds us in His love.

On Saturday, April 10 at 4:00 mass we celebrated First Communion with our young people. Please pray for them as they received the Eucharist for the first time. Pray for them that they may always know the mercy of God as He calls them to Himself.
