## From Msgr. Harrington...

It is a blessing, a moment of grace, to pause in the busyness of our day and discover a place of wonder. Often our reflection is spurred on by an appreciation of God's creation, its beauty, its perfection, its glory in its imperfection. We look upon a sunset or a sunrise and see the fingerprint of God. We study an open field or a moss-draped oak and something stirs within us. There is a sacred connection made. This is wonder.

I have often heard from people who like to hunt or fish in the early hours of the day how beautiful the pre-morning introduction of the dawn. They speak of sitting in a duck blind and observing the birth of the day in all its splendor, the glory of birds taking flight in the morning mist. I've witnessed others who see a work of art and are transported to a different world. I've had

Opportunity to stand humbly beneath the vaulted ceiling of the Sistine Chapel and marvel at Michelangelo's masterpiece. I've stood speechless before the statue of David in Florence and the Pieta in St. Peter's in the Vatican.

There was a time when I stayed on a small island on the Great Barrier Reef off the coast of Australia and watched whales dance in the Pacific Ocean and sea turtles clamber upon the beach to lay their eggs. Or when I watched ice skaters on the frozen ponds in downtown Toronto as snowflakes drifted gracefully to the ground.

But you really do not have to travel far to wonder. There are surprises from God around every corner of every day. This can be in your garden or your backyard. This can be at a campground or a beach or downtown or in the country, at work or at play. Wonder can be sought and experienced anywhere at any time. It is as if God is saying to us, "Look what I have prepared for you, look what I have created for you at this time, in this moment, in this place. See it and appreciate it. See my hand at work. See your God at play. Fall in love with my creation."

Let us not be so caught up with what preoccupies us so that we forget to wonder. Let us not be so blinded by being busy with what we perceive as so important that we miss the surprises of God. Let us pause to wonder. Let us pause to give thanks to God for all His precious gifts to us.
