A Message from Msgr. Harrington ...

We've all seen children opening gifts on birthdays or at Christmas. We've seen how excited they are when they love the gift or how unimpressed they are with socks or something practical and not wonder-inspired. What is our response to the gift of the Holy Eucharist?

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ? Do we respond in our hearts with the joy and enthusiasm of a child? Is this gift so precious to us that we set aside all the others? Are we passionately grateful that Jesus chose to share His very self with us for eternity? Do we consistently give thanks for the Son, both human and divine, who took simple elements of bread and wine on the night before He died and urged His disciples to partake of this life-giving food? This same life-giving food that is shared with us two thousand years later.

When Jesus surrendered Himself before the violence and hatred of the world, He could not abandon the ones He loved and leave them empty handed. He could not turn away and pretend they meant nothing to Him even though they would abandon and betray Him. They belonged to Him, so He gave them Himself. He gives us Himself.

The body and blood of Jesus Christ is our nourishment, our sustenance along the journey. The body and blood of Jesus Christ is what help us to yearn for the Father, for union with the Son and the Spirit. This precious gift is what reminds us we are not a forgotten people, an annoyance set aside, a pebble in God's shoe.

This precious gift reminds us that we are beloved and share the gift with all the beloved. We do this in memory of Him. It's who we are. It's who we are called to be: The Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.
