**Pastoral Reflection**

*From the Desk of Msgr. Harrington....*

The Lord's Prayer has some disturbing and dangerous parts that we sometimes quickly dance through. It is relatively easy to give praise to the Father and express our beliefs in His kingdom and His will. We readily ask for our daily bread, but then slam into the scary part.

“Forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.” If we closely study what we are praying at this time in this beautiful prayer from Jesus, we can understand why we skip through this part like a child running from an imaginary monster. Who in their right mind wants to be forgiven in the same way they forgive? Who wants to be measured with the same criteria with which they measure?

We want to be measured with a multitude of gallon buckets, not the single thimble we use to measure others. We want to be forgiven the way God forgives, not the way we forgive. We forgive with squinty eyes and suspicious hearts. We forgive with an open hand before us and a closed fist behind our backs. We say we forgive, but we are pretty confident in our ability to never forget, to hold on to hurts well into our senior years.

Jesus challenges us in this prayer to be forgivers, not wardens of a penitentiary of others' wrongs. This is a bold and daring invitation of the Shepherd to enter into His Most Sacred Heart and to discover the capacity within ourselves to forgive. We are asked to demand forgiveness from ourselves as we seek to join Him in loving others. We are asked to forgive freely and fiercely, placing no demands on the forgiven. Can we forgive like that? Are we capable of loving others like that? We must be, because He assures us that we can, we must. He fills us with His presence to accomplish this great miraculous endeavor to become forgiving.

Forgiveness is essential to the mission of a disciple.

- **The Little Cajun Saint** - On August 11, 1959 a young 12 year old girl from Richard, Louisiana died at Our Lady of Lourdes after a brief, but difficult battle with acute Lymphatic Leukemia.
