Pastoral Reflection

From the Desk of Msgr. Harrington...

Before the tragedy of the first sin, Adam, Eve and God would walk together in the cool of the evening. It was the perfect time for them to share life with each other. It was the perfect time for them to 'be' for each other.

What were their conversations like? Did they expound on the beauty of the creation? Did their words dance with the rhythm of the splendor of the Creator? Did they sing together? Did they laugh together? Did they dream together?

So much was lost when decisions were made contrary to the Heart of the Creator. So much intimacy was cast aside like rubbish. Shame entered creation and brought to Adam and Eve the need to hide from the One who loved them so desperately, who missed their walks together, who missed the whispers of their souls.

Why would they jeopardize the friendship of a Father who only wanted to love them? Why would they risk the ownership of the breath of God for a brief taste of a forbidden fruit? We might ask ourselves the very same questions.

Sin not only hurts others, but it injures our own selves. The residual effects mold us into beings who doubt ourselves, distrust ourselves, distrust God, question His profound love for us at very core of our being, and force us to hide in bushes of shame.

But that is not His will for us. He searches for the lost and embraces the broken. He takes the shattered earthen vessel, fills it with grace and calls it His own. He doesn't leave it by the roadside. He picks us up, kisses us with love, and holds us close to His heart, over and over again. His mercy never tires. His forgiveness is never spent.

His true will is to bring us back to the garden and walk with Him in the cool of the evening. That's where we find Him. That's where we find ourselves.

- St. Bernard Parish In 1847, the parish of St. Bernard in Breaux Bridge was the seventh Church parish founded in the Diocese of Lafayette, and the fourth along the banks of the Bayou Teche. Under the administration of Father Antoine Borias parish life flourished from 1888 to 1900. It was during this time that two young Cajun men from Breaux Bridge entered seminary. When they were ordained, they were two of the first three local vocations. Previously, many of the European priests believed the Cajun people were not capable of becoming priests. One of those two priests from Breaux Bridge was Jules Jeanmard, Lafayette's first Bishop. August 20th is the Feast of St. Bernard.
