Gratitude to Msgr. Melancon...

Over the years, many in our community were blessed to know and be ministered to by Msgr. Louis Melancon. His pilgrimage to the Father has challenged us in our grief to be grateful for the gift he was to this community.

He was not only generous in life but managed to be generous also in his passing. His legacy to both the parish community and the Opelousas Catholic School community was extremely generous. For the parish community his gift gives us the opportunity to become debt-free and enables us to plan for future projects.

As pastor of St. Landry Church, I want to express our gratitude to this wondrous, generous man of God who served humbly and graciously. One of the projects Fr. James Brady began during his pastorate was the planning and future construction of a mausoleum for the church. It is with no hesitation that I have decided to name the future mausoleum the Msgr. Louis Melancon Mausoleum and dedicate it to the memory of Msgr. Melancon, our friend and brother. Since it will be built near the school he loved, it seemed appropriate to have it bear his name.

He was born on September 15, 1935 in Plattenville, Louisiana to Louis J. Melancon and Hazel Boudreaux Melancon. He did seminary studies at Notre Dame Seminary in New Orleans and St. John Seminary in Little Rock, Arkansas. Msgr. Melancon was ordained a priest on May 25, 1963 at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist in Lafayette, Louisiana.

His assignments included the following: Associate Pastor at St. Landry, Opelousas, St. Henry, Lake Charles, Our Lady Queen of Heaven, Lake Charles; Director of Vocations, Spiritual Director of Immaculata Seminary and Director of Permanent Diaconate; Pastor of Immaculate Conception, Lake Charles, St. Raphael, Iowa, St. John Bosco, Westlake, St. Theodore, Moss Bluff, St. Peter, Grand Prairie and Administrator of Our Lady of Mercy, Opelousas. He was named Prelate of Honor on June 3, 1990, giving him the title of Monsignor. Throughout the years, he served on the Priests' Senate, Diocesan Ecumenical Council, Diocesan School Board, Cursillo in Prairie Rhonde, the Clergy Advisory Board and served as a Diocesan Consultant for the Diocese of Lake Charles. In 1992 he was named an Episcopal Vicar and served for five years. He retired from the active priesthood on July 1, 2005, but never retired from priestly ministry.

Let us remember Msgr. Melancon with joy as he claims his place as a good and faithful servant. Let us remember him with love as he enjoys the fullness of the Father's embrace.

- 50 Year old Parish - In our Centennial Year, only one parish is celebrating its 50th Anniversary. In 1968, St. Pius X Church was designated a parish community. A small building on Kaliste Saloom Road had served as a mission church since 1959. In the first 50 years of the Diocese of Lafayette, 68 church parishes were established. After St. Pius in 1968, only 8 other churches would be established as a parish in the Diocese over the following 50 years. On October 5, 2017, the new St. Pius X Church was dedicated by Bishop Deshotel. The massive structure is a far cry from the original warehouse used in 1968.
