## Pastoral Reflection 12

Recently, Pope Francis canonized a number of persons as saints of the Catholic Church. These extraordinary individuals did more than 'talk the talk'. They lived the Gospel of Jesus Christ as faithfully as they could, no matter the cost. Each one in his or her own way reflected the Father's love for the Son by living a life filled with the Spirit.

One person recently canonized is Archbishop Oscar Romero of El Salvador. Because he recognized the special place of the poor in God's heart, he served them fiercely and stood by their side as best he could. He spoke a gospel of love and lived that same gospel.

Even when his life was threatened, Oscar Romero did not flinch from his calling. He was a servant of God's poor to the very end. His message of justice could not be silenced.

At the age of 62 while he was celebrating the Sacred Liturgy in the chapel of the Hospital of Divine Providence, Archbishop Romero was assassinated/martyred on March 24, 1980. What tremendous courage it must have taken to celebrate mass publicly knowing full well your vulnerability before an assassin's bullet. To have the faith in a life-giving, just God who stands by you every step of the way, even in death, even in resurrection – what gift, what an amazing grace.

Who are these people the church recognizes in this way? They are us; everyday people living everyday lives. They know and see the face of God everywhere in everybody. They know and see Jesus of Nazareth every day. These people walk with us as well. What a gift to know that Oscar Romero walks with each of us in our journey with Jesus, nudging us towards the gospel of justice, our true legacy of freedom, our pathway of love.

- **A dream comes true** - In October 1948, a long held dream of Bishop Jeanmard came true. Lafayette was to have a minor seminary for young men to begin their studies towards the priesthood. Thirty-three young men were in the first class of students. The official dedication of Immaculata Minor Seminary took place on October 24, 1949, with Bishop Cicognani, the Pope's apostolic delegate to the United States, officiating. The seminary was run by the Society of Mary (Marists) who served as faculty, and the Sisters of the Holy Family who oversaw the domestic arrangements. Immaculata Seminary consisted of four years of high school and the first two years of college. It closed as a seminary in 1977.
