Exodus 17:3-7 Water flowed from rock to quench the people's thirst.

Psalms 95 "If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts."

Romans 5:1-2, 5-8 God's love is poured into our hearts in the gift of the Spirit.

John 4: 5-42 The water Jesus gives is the wellspring of eternal life.

Water takes center stage in scripture today. The Chosen People grow thirsty in the desert and the Lord provides water from the rock in Horeb. The Psalmist recalls this event to urge us not to harden our hearts as they did. Paul suggests the image of water in stating that the love of God has been poured into our hearts. 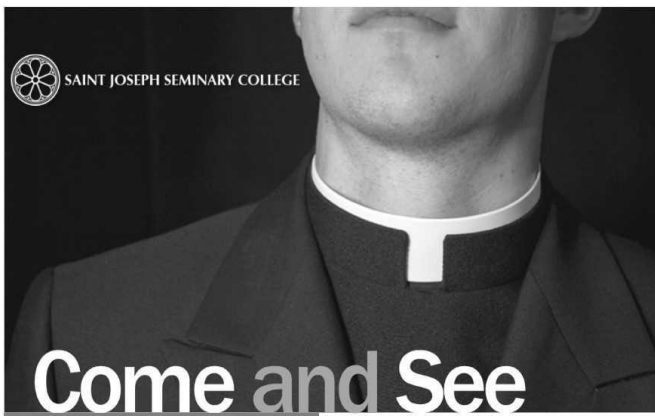

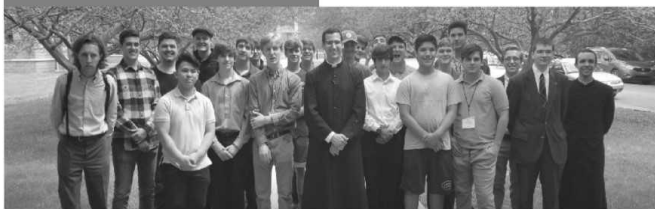

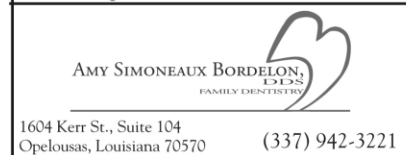
